Meters would be placed on Highway 27 and the private owners will pay to extend service lines to the proposed houses. These service lines will be maintained solely by owners because they will be private lines, and they are outside water and sewer customers.

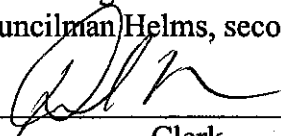
Council does not want to call for a public hearing for rezoning of Crescent Resources property near I-85 at the Gateway area.

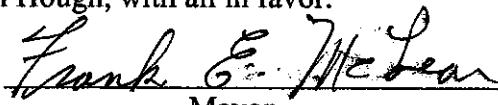
