

Special Meeting
Mount Holly City Council
February 22, 1996

This special meeting was held in City Hall, and was called to order by Mayor Frank E. McLean at 7:00 P.M. Those present were Councilmembers Harris, Hope, Duke, Stewart and Hostetler, as well as Mayor Pro Tem Michael Helms, City Manager Phil Ponder, City Attorney Kemp Michael, and Public Works Director Eddie Nichols.

The purpose of the special meeting was to discuss a proposed interconnect agreement with the Town of Stanley, but because of concerns associated with recent policy changes related to commercial garbage collection, Mayor McLean allowed discussion about the matter. Ms. Linda Ashendorf and Mr. Jamie Amick of BFI appeared before Council to express concerns about the recent policy changes. They indicated that the policy change prohibiting the collection of dumpsters between 9:00 P.M. and 7:00 A. M. had caused great difficulty in safely collecting the garbage of twelve businesses. Mr. and Mrs. Ron Dimmer also appeared to voice concern about the policy change. The City Manager indicated that he would attempt to work through these problems with BFI and report back to Council at a future meeting.

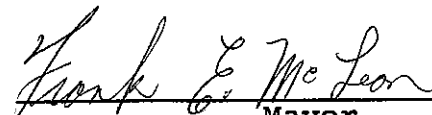
Staff updated Council on negotiations with the Town of Stanley regarding a proposed sewer interconnect. Mr. Ray Patterson of Dutch Avenue questioned Council about sewage problems adjacent to his property. Mayor McLean informed Mr. Patterson that the Mount Holly/Stanley sewer interconnect would not impact his property, but that Council had recently approved a plan to address his problem that would be constructed in the next fiscal year. Council agreed with the points of the proposal addressed by staff, and directed the City Attorney to draft a formal agreement.

Councilmember Phyllis Harris expressed concern about a meeting that was conducted between several councilmembers and MPO Transportation Planner George Cobb. As Transportation Advisory Committee (TAC) delegate, she felt that matters should be addressed through her.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
