CITY MANAGER APPLICATIONS

Councilwoman Harris reported that the committee had separated the 62 applications received. Councilman Stewart said they are in four groups, namely, those that meet the criteria for education and experience, those that do not have either, those with education but not experience, and those with experience but without the degree. He wanted to speak generally about what kind of person they are hoping to hire, related to managerial styles. City Attorney Michael reminded Council they had agreed to keep names confidential of applicants. The Council agreed to eliminate the applications with neither the education nor the degree. The Council agreed to discuss the remaining applications in closed session.

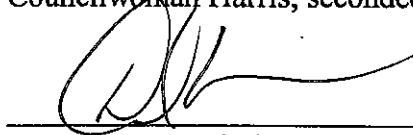
Closed Session

Councilman Hough MOVED to go into closed session for the purpose of considering applications submitted for the position of City Manager, seconded by Councilman Black, with all present in favor.

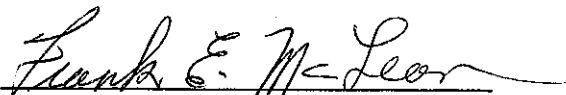
Councilman Hough MOVED to return to open session, seconded by Councilwoman Harris, with all present in favor.
