Mayor Black stated that council will need to set a date for the referendum if they want to move it per Mr. Elliot's suggestion. A consensus was reached to leave the date in June.

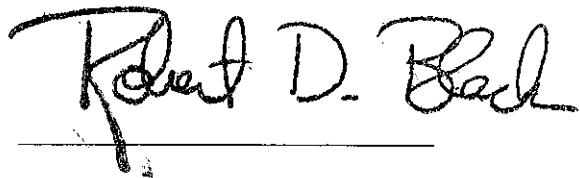
Item # 2 on the Agenda – Soil Erosion and Control.
