

Special Meeting
Mount Holly City Council
January 5, 1995

The special meeting was called to order by Mayor Pro Tem Bob Jessen at 7:30 P.M. Those present were Mayor Pro Tem Bob Jessen, Councilwoman Phyllis Harris, Councilmen Archie Small, Michael Helms, and Jim Hope, as well as City Manager Phil Ponder, City Attorney Kemp Michael and Personnel Consultant Rebecca Veazey. Mayor Charles Black and Councilman R. L. Duke were not present.

The City Council reviewed the personnel policy proposed by staff. After due deliberation, Council made the following changes to the proposed document:

1. the section providing for longevity pay was eliminated;
2. the King Holiday was not added as a city holiday;
3. provisions for retiree health insurance were expanded to include family coverage paid for at retiree's expense.

Upon MOTION of Councilman Hope, seconded by Council Helms, and unanimously carried, Council repealed Section 2-21, Personnel, of the Code of Ordinances.

Upon MOTION of Councilman Hope, seconded by Council Helms, and carried with four ayes and one nay (Small), Council adopted Resolution 1/5/95A, the amended personnel policy and pay plan.

Upon MOTION of Councilman Hope, seconded by Councilman Helms, and unanimously carried Council Option III (attached) as presented by the City Manager for implementation onto the pay plan.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
