

Special Meeting
Mount Holly City Council
January 2, 1996

This special meeting was held in City Hall, and was called to order by Mayor Frank E. McLean at 7:00 P.M. Those present were Councilmembers Harris, Hope, Duke, Stewart and Hostetler, as well as Mayor Pro Tem Michael Helms, City Manager Phil Ponder, Police Chief Jerry Bishop, and Police Records Manager Miranda Pennington.

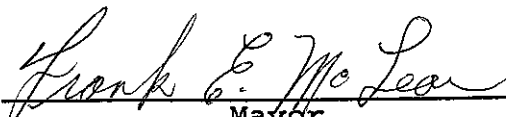
City Council discussed a variety of matters. Those of significance are as follows:

1. Council directed the City Manager to schedule a joint meeting with the Planning Commission for 7:30 P.M. on February 5, 1996 to discuss the process for adopting the new zoning ordinance.
2. Chief Bishop appeared before Council to discuss reports requested by the City Council. Council directed that the matter be placed upon the January 8, 1996 regular meeting agenda for further review.
3. Council indicated that they would be anxious to discuss a sewer interconnect with the Town of Stanley, and agreed to meet with representatives from their Council at the January 22nd Special Meeting.
4. The City Manager was directed to request that MPO Transportation Planner George Cobb appear at a meeting in the near future to discuss the role of the MPO in transportation planning.
5. Council authorized Councilmember Harris to pursue appropriate blinds for the City Hall at a price not to exceed \$5,000.
6. The City Manager reported no progress in efforts to find a means to remove public housing from the control of the City.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
