

Special Meeting
Mount Holly City Council
November 4, 1996

The special meeting was held at City Hall, and was called to order by Mayor Frank McLean. Those present were Mayor Pro Tem Michael Helms, Councilwoman Phyllis Harris, Councilmen Jim Hope, R. L. Duke, David Hostetler, Jr. and Andy Stewart, as well as City Manager Phil Ponder and City Attorney Kemp Michael.

The purpose of this special meeting was to discuss a request from the Gaston County YMCA for a \$250,000 donation over a five year period to assist with their efforts to construct an eastern branch of the YMCA in Mount Holly. City Attorney Kemp Michael cautioned Council that he had concerns about the legality of a cash donation to the YMCA. City Manager Phil Ponder agreed with the City Attorney, and indicated that Council might consider infrastructure improvements as a way not only to help the YMCA, but assist with development in the entire area. City Council indicated that they would consider the construction of a road and water and sewer improvements in the area at their November 11th regular meeting, as a way of assisting the YMCA with their development.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
