Background/Purpose of Request :	
As a response to the August 5, 2011 flood, US Infrastructure of Carolina, Inc. (USI) was retained to analyze the existing storm drainage systems, existing topographical conditions and contributing drainage area. USI using hydrology and hydraulic analysis prepared several alternatives that would reduce the chances of flooding based on a 100-year storm event. Based on the review of the proposed alternatives and discussions with staff and effected property owners, we have prepared a plan of action for implementation of a drainage solution in the Downtown area. Funds will need to be allocated for the design and construction of the proposed drainage improvements. We are also seeking Council concurrence with the design and implementation of the proposed drainage improvements.

Background/Purpose of Request : Mike Santmire, Streets & Solid Waste Director, came before you at the September Work Session to discuss speed limits in the city. More specifically, Mr. Santmire outlined the need to make adjustments to specific areas regarding speed limits. Upon an extensive discussion with the City Council and staff it was determined that changes were needed. However, there is now a need to seek clarification of the matter due to what is perceived to be the direction of the City Council and what is actually recommended by the city staff. The gist of the matter is that it appears that the City Council is directing staff to institute a city wide speed limit of 25 miles per hour. This does not coincide with what staff has recommended, which was mentioned in a weekly update shortly after the September Work Session. On Monday night I would like an opportunity to discuss the matter and finalize the direction of the City Council.
