October 28, 1996

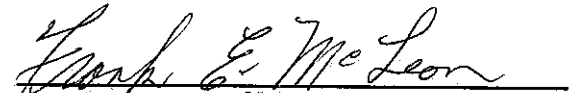
The special meeting was held at the corporate headquarters of American & Efird Mills located on American Street, and was called to order by Mayor Frank McLean at 11:30 A.M. Elected officials present included Mayor Pro-Tem Michael Helms, Councilwoman Phyllis Harris, Councilmen Jim Hope, R. L. Duke, Andy Stewart and David Hostetler. YMCA representatives present included John Suddes, Phil Morgan and Steve Crane.
