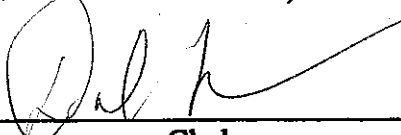
The first matter for discussion by Council was issues regarding increase in water pressure in Oakcrest Subdivision. Rick Eldridge said that he has not had any problems at his house but there are leaks out in the street, and several people in the neighborhood have had problems in their houses. Public Works Director Eddie Nichols said the State has no maximum pressure for water service. He stated that the average pressure throughout the City is 40-50 psi. Ray Williams said his water pressure was very high. Eddie Nichols said that notice of water pressure increase was hand delivered in June. Councilwoman Harris said next time better notification should be made by mail and put it in the newspaper also. Staff was instructed to study the problem and recommend to the City Manager regarding handling of change.

Council discussed the agenda for the next regular meeting.

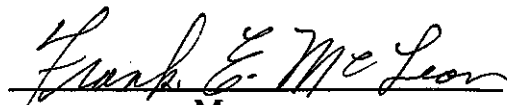
Eddie Nichols explained that the State will require the City to obtain a permit for the individual pumps at each house in StoneWater Bay. In turn, the homeowners association will hold the City harmless from any permit violations. The City plans to amend its sewer use ordinance to handle this process.
