CALL TO ORDER BY THE MAYOR

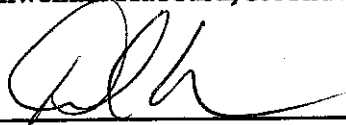
The special meeting of the City Council of Mount Holly was called to order at 7:00 P.M. by Mayor McLean. The following were present:

Council discussed the contents of a letter dated 9-22-99 from Barbara Lockwood, Chair of the Mt. Island Lake Marine Commission, with comments regarding suggestions for development for StoneWater Bay Subdivision. Council reached a consensus that the homeowners association should be responsible for individual pump stations but the City would be responsible for piped storm water provided right of way is granted the City. Also, the homeowners association should be responsible for sedimentation basins. Council wants 15 foot buffers along wetlands. Council wants to explore having a city ordinance regarding erosion control. The sewer retention basin will be moved back 1,400 feet from its present location and will have one hour holding time.
