

Special Meeting
Mount Holly City Council
September 23, 1991

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 P.M. by Mayor Charles B. Black, Jr. Those present were Councilwoman Faye S. Little and Lib Nichols, Councilmen Myles Biggerstaff, R. L. Duke, Archie Small, Mayor Pro-Tem Bob Jessen, City Manager Greg Young.

Councilwoman Little made a motion to go into executive session for personnel matters and attorney-client relations. Councilman Duke seconded the motion, with all in favor.

A motion was made by Councilwoman Little to go out of executive session, with a second by Councilman Duke, with all in favor.

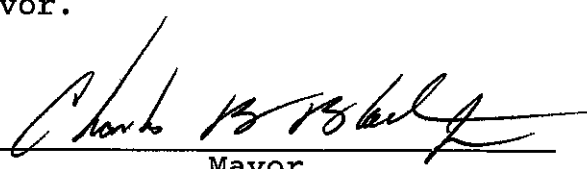
Councilman Biggerstaff made a motion for the City to enter into a contract with Prime Management, Inc. to provide an interim City Manager. The negotiations and execution of the contract shall be conducted by the City Manager, Mayor and City Attorney, and the term to begin September 30, 1991. There was a second to the motion by Councilwoman Little, with all in favor.

The City Manager was asked to draft a letter for the Board which would be read at the Tuesday meeting regarding the Nims tract development.

There was a discussion regarding the burning of a house on the Nims property. A motion was made by Councilwoman Little not to let the Fire Dept. burn down the house on the Nims property. Councilman Duke seconded the motion, with all in favor, except Councilman Small.
