Mount Holly City Council
June 17, 1991

The Mount Holly City Council met for a special called meeting on June 17, 1991. Mayor Charles B. Black, Jr. called the meeting to order, with Councilwomen Faye S. Little and Lib Nichols, Mayor Pro-Tem Bob Jessen, Councilmen Myles Biggerstaff, Archie Small, and R. L. Duke all present.

Councilman Archie Small gave the invocation.

The proposed amendments for the 1990-91 fiscal year budget were discussed. A motion was made by Councilwoman Little to accept the proposed amendments to the 1990-91 fiscal year budget submitted by the City Manager, with a second to the motion by Councilman Small, with all in favor.

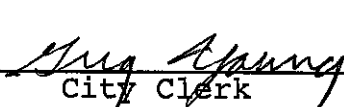
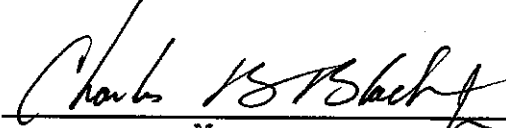
There was much discussion, but no action on the proposed fiscal year budget for 1991-1992. An interim budget was then discussed, and Councilwoman Little made a motion to adopt the proposed interim budget for fiscal year 1991-1992, beginning July 1, 1991 and ending July 30, 1991. Mayor Pro-Tem Jessen seconded the motion, with all in favor.

A motion was made by Councilman Biggerstaff for the City to accept maintenance of Second Street, between Henry and Cherry Sts. Councilman Duke seconded the motion, with all in favor.

Mayor Pro-Tem Jessen made a motion to go into executive session, Councilwoman Nichols seconded the motion, with all in favor.

Councilman Duke made a motion to go out of executive session, with a second by Councilwoman Little, with all in favor.

Councilman Duke made the motion to adjourn, Councilman Small seconded the motion, with all in favor.
