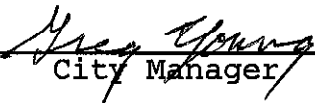


Special Meeting

May 29, 1991

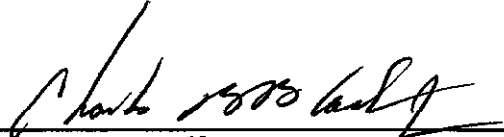
There was a special meeting called for the Mayor and City Council to meet with the postal officials regarding the Mount Holly Post Office. Those present were Mayor Charles B. Black, Jr., Mayor Pro-Tem Bob Jessen, Councilwomen Faye S. Little and Lib Nichols, Councilman R. L. Duke, Luther Starnes and Laverne Ellis, postal representatives. The postal officials met with Mayor Black privately before the meeting started, and requested to speak to each council member individually regarding postal complaints.

At 10:50 A.M., after talking to postal representatives individually, Councilman Duke and Councilwoman Little left, and there was no longer a quorum of council members present to conduct any official business on behalf of the City. There were still many people present in the Council Room that were scheduled to talk individually with postal representatives at fifteen minute increments, from 10:30 A.M. until 2:00 P.M. (see attached list of appointments)

At 11:10 A.M. postal representatives decided to meet with everyone at one time publicly. People began voicing their complaints openly, one at a time.
